SHARNBASVESHWAR SAMASTHAN











Established in the 18th Century, the Sharnbasveshwara Samasthana has a rich cultural heritage and was primarily responsible for setting the tone for the culture of 'Dashoha' (Giving or Satisfying the Needs of Needy). The Samasthana which began its selfless service by providing the needy millions free food during the worstever famine in the year of its establishment expanded its horizons of activities by quenching the thirst of the knowledge to the billions of the deprived sections of the society.

The name of the Samsthana derives from the mystic saint par excellence Mahadasohi Sharnbasveshwar, who with his selfless service to the people in need has been recognized by the devotees as a great humanitarian and was embodiment of Dasoha culture. The principles of Sharanabasaveshwar on which institutions are built and operated is that "No Religion is Greater that service to humanity is service to God...It is beautiful thing, You serve humanbeings. You are serving the God, it is is very inspiring indeed" These were the words of praise by former President late Dr A P J Abdul Kalaam during his visit to Samasthan.

The life of Saint Sharanabasaveshwar itself is an example of supreme sacrifice for the sake of suffering humanity. It was this saint who made the Dasoha philosophy a way of life and set an example for other religious mutts to follow the principles of Anna Dasoha.

In the 19th Century major portions of the region faced one of the worstever famine with scores of people falling prey to the hunger deaths. It was at this time when Saint Sharanabasaveshwar who was on his pilgrimage to Basavakalyan saw the sufferings of the people and decided to devote his life to provide relief to the needy people. As per the legend the Saint used to reach out the rich landlords in the region by foot and collect the foodgrains to start gruel centres in different parts of the district to provide succorto the hungry masses.

Even today the tradition of the people, particularly, the farmers of the regions donating part of their harvested foodgrains to the Dasoha Mahamane in the Sharanabasaveshwar Samasthan to feed the devotees visiting the temple continued. In the selfless service rendered by Saint Sharanabasaveshwar to alleviate to the suffering of the hunger struck humanity, the contribution and support extended by his contemporary Adi Doddappa Sharanaru, a rich landlord of the region, was immense and both served the humanity like the twins and remained like siamese twins throughout their life.

Sharanaru in their long association had lived and followed the principles of Guru-Shishya tradition. It was Poojya Adi Doddappa Sharanaru who succeeded Saint Sharanabasaveshwar as the second peetathipathi of the Samasthan after the Saint, the first peetathipathi, attained Samadhi.

The fire lighted in the kitchen established by Saint Sharanabasaveshwar in the Sharanabasaveshwar Samasthan in the 18th Century, to provide gruel to the people facing one of the worst famine, is still kept alive and even today the devotees visiting the Sharanbasaveshwar Shrine to pay their obeisance from far and near are never allowed to go with their empty stomach and free 'prasada' (food) is provided in a conducive environment in the Dasoha Mahamane in the Sharanabasaveshwar Shrine premises.

The traditions setforth by Saint Sharanabasaveshwara and Doddappa Appa in the 19th Century has been followed religiously by the successive Peetathpathis of the Sharanabasaveshwar Samasthan and the Shrine is a must visit place daily for every devout Hindu

living in Kalaburagi city and any religious ceremonies and festivals performed by the temple throughout the year is practiced as their own festivals by every single house in the Kalaburagi city.

As a furtherance to the philosophy of Dasoha, the 6th Peetathipathi of the Sharanabasaveshwar Samasthan established the Sharanabasaveshwar Vidya Vardhaka Sangha in 1903 and this signaled the unending journey of Samasthana and Sangha in providing Shikshana Dasoha (Educational Service) alongside the Anna Dasoha. The first school of the Sangha was established in the Dasoha Mahamane way back in 1903 and this has blossomed like a beautiful lotus as a full fledged private university –Sharanbasva University, the first in the entire Hyderabad Karnataka region.

In the field of Education, the Sangha had achieved many firsts including the first public library established in 1918 by the 7th Peetathipati Poojya Doddappa Appaji, father of the present Peetathipathi Poojya Dr Sharnbaswappa Appaji. The concept of starting a public library in the year 1918 got the rare appreciation from none other











than the then President Dr A P J Abdul Kalaam during his visit to Kalaburagi to inaugurate the centenary celebrations of the Sangha.

The Sangha was also the first to establish a girls school way back in 1934, at the time when the education to the women was a far cry. Incidentally 1934 is also the Birth year of the present peetathipathi Poojya Dr Appaji. It was the strong commitment of Poojya Doddappa Appaji towards women's empowerment that gave the new avenues of education to the girls in the region. The Sangha had arranged horse drawn "Tangas" to ferry the girl students from their individual houses to the school. The Sangha's iniatives did not limit to the conventional courses, but was the first institution to start the Post Graduate course in Fine Arts and Music.

Continuing this tradition of women empowerment in the field of education, the present Peetathipathi of the Samasthan and President of the Sangha Poojya Dr Appaji established the first engineering college exclusively for the women in the entire North Karnataka in 2011. The Godutai Engineering College for Women started by the Sangha was a huge success and not a single seat in the different courses offered by the college went unfulfilled from the day the college began functioning.

Although Poojya Doddappa Appaji gave the required fillip to the educational activities of the

institutions including degree colleges in the region, the period of his successor Poojya Dr Sharnbasawappa Appa is considered as the golden age for the Sangha and it was during his reign the Sangha stepped into the horizon of the higher education and professional education by starting four engineering colleges, umpteen number of Post Graduate programmes, including the MTTM (tourism).

More than 25,000 students pursue their different academic courses of their choice in the institutions under the Sharnbasya University and

More than 25,000 students pursue their different academic courses of their choice in the institutions under the Sharnbasva University and the educational institutions under the Sharanabasaveshwar Vidya Vardak Sangha. There were 3000 plus teaching and non teaching staff in the four campuses of the University at Kalaburagi, Basavakalyan and Bidar in Bidar district and Surpur in Yadgir district). The Sangha was also the first in the entire region to establish Engineering Colleges in remote taluk Headquarters at Basavakalyan in Bidar district and Surpur in Yadgir district.

Starting the engineering colleges at the remote taluk headquarters provided the much needed opportunity to the students, particularly the women to pursue professional courses and many students have passed out with distinction and ranks from these two engineering colleges at Surpur and Basavakalyan.

Quality Education is the hallmark of both the Sharnbasva University and the Sharna basaveshwar Vidya Vardak Sangha and there are no compromises on the quality of the teaching staff and only the best available human resource is selected and the hardworking teaching staff and equally merited students have brought laurels to the University and Sangha by gaining fruitful employment in the campus interviews by the reputed companies.















The Sharnbasva University is the first University in the entire North Karnataka to step into the zone of tapping the renewable energy sources to meet the entire power requirement of the University and also use every drop of rain water for meeting the water requirement of the University as a step forward to convert the University campus a green one.



The University which had set an example in creating one of the largest rain harvesting structure in the engineering colleges in the campus in Kalaburagi city, is now all set to inaugurate the 400 KV solar power generation from the solar panels installed on the roof tops of the 11 buildings of the University to meet 75 per cent of the power requirement of the University. This is one of the biggest grid connected roof top solar power plant in the state duly approved by the GESCOM.

No other university, whether it is a private or a conventional university in the entire North Karnataka region, has taken such an initiative for the production of green power through a renewable source of energy and contributing their might to prevent serious environmental damage.

Chancellor of the University Poojya Dr Sharnbasvappa Appa is the guiding force behind the initiative for tapping the solar energy. The production of the solar energy in the University campus would not only cut down the expenditure on the payment of electricity charges every month to the tune of Rs Rs 3 lakhs every month, the University would be contributing its might for the reduction of the carbon print on the environment.

As per an estimation 920 grams of carbon footprint is left behind in the production of one unit of power in a thermal power plant and by producing 400 KV power tapping the solar energy the University helped in preventing 960 tonnes of carbon footprint on the environment every year.

One of the striking features of the entire initiative was that University has not spent even a single rupee in the entire initiative and the Ahmedbad based Gensol Engineering Pvt Ltd has invested nearly Rs 3 Crore for installing 1875 solar panels in an area of 10,360 square meters in the roof tops of 11 buildings.

They said the University on its part, as per the power purchase agreement entered between the University and the GENSOL, the University would purchase the power generated from the solar panel at a cost of Rs 3.64 paise per unit for 25 years from the day of production. Atpresent the University is paying Rs 7.40 per unit to the GESCOM for the power supplied to the University now.

The installation of the solar panel has been completed in a record time of eight months and the University has already written to the GESCOM for the grid connectivity so that the power production could begin immediately.

The Centre of Excellence has designed career oriented courses for the students in the enterprise level networking skills. For the students of the Sharnbasva University these courses were being free of cost and the examination cost by the CISCO is also borne by the University.









The short duration course would enable the students to get hands on training in best practices from the entry level to expert level. The BMW has provided training to the faculty of the Mechanical Engineering Department in handling the high value engine and gears gifted by them. This initiative was being taken up by the BMW to fill the gap between what the technology was there in the world and what the students were being taught in the technical educational institutions.
